[Motion on Creating a Mental Health Rep on the Disabled Students' Committeel

The Council Notes:

- The Disabled Students' Group have the role to campaign and raise awareness of a variety of disabilities across the campus.
- It has been recognised that Mental Health is a growing concern, especially for students when coming to university wherein 1 in 5 students consider themselves to have a mental health problem.¹
- The Disabled Students' Group have worked alongside a number of people and organisations with particular focus on Mental Health.

The Council Believes:

- The Disabled Students' Group must aim to have particular focus on a variety of disabilities which, for example, include physical and learning disabilities and difficulties.
- Mental Health is to be regarded a very relatable concern for students at university and should be pursued throughout the year.

The Council Resolves:

- To propose creating a Mental Health Rep on the Disabled Students' Committee
- This will ensure assistance and representation to those with mental health problems throughout the year, working with the Campaigns Officer.
- The role will make it easier to communicate effectively with the many different people and organisations which also focus on mental health.
